Respect. Remember the last time you heard a kid act respectfully? It's sad to

say, but you were kind of shocked, weren't you? Impressed, but also shocked. We often hear someone say these days, "You have to earn my respect!". It's said like a challenge and certainly not in a friendly tone. Who wants to bend over backward for that person? Who is going to end up friends with someone beginning things that way? In my mind, respect should be freely given. Counterpoint: I've been told a number of times that I can be too harsh and unforgiving. That's fine (and probably pretty accurate). However, I truly believe it's best to begin something with a positive mindset and the best of intentions. If things don't go that way, fine, I can adapt (enter the harshness part). But I do sincerely try to be kind, fair, and open at the beginning – it simply makes no sense to me not to begin that way.

About five years ago, I hired a new employee. She was fairly young but very bright, professional, with excellent credentials, and carried herself exceptionally well. She was a fast learner and was doing beautifully

in no time. None of those are what worth having that are. made her stand out to me, however. I say with great pride that everyone I work with has those qualities (though some of us aren't exactly "fairly young"). At the time of her hiring, our office was small, so it was sometimes hard not to overhear other conversations. I often heard her saying "Yes, sir" and "No, ma'am" and that stood out to me, and I started paying more attention. People in person and on the phone gravitated toward her because she offered respect freely. I noticed that her doing this made two things happen: people that were unfriendly became much more friendly, and people who were already friendly just adored her. It's like she had a superpower. It dawned on me that her superpower of being polite and respectful is simply because those two qualities are so rare these days. Our insurance agency continues to grow, and I've made it a point to make those qualities a requirement for each new hire. Solid proof of the benefit of this principle is how well we all get along here in the office – another rarity in today's work environment. I argue that being respectful to your work colleagues, family, and friends cannot but have a positive impact on your life. Having a culture that offers respect, in turn, gets respect. It's not always easy, but there are very few things in life

I say all of this because I suspect social media, specifically, and our culture in general, has damn near killed respect. Have you ever heard of the bucket of crabs story? In short, there is a bucket full of crabs. When one near the top has almost escaped, one of the other crabs pulls him back in. It's a story highlighting the mentality of "If I can't have it, neither can you!". How does that relate to social media? It is largely applauded if someone posts some positive accomplishment in a small circle of family and friends. However, there is a weird phenomenon if you get a big enough audience, people will start attacking you for posting something positive. On the other hand, if you post how you're a victim, everyone competes to applaud you. If you post something about overcoming being a victim, then again, a large enough audience will attack you. It's like social media has reversed what made America, America. For 245 years, we'd watch someone succeed, and instead of feeling envy, we would think, "That will be me one day!" Success stories powered us and made us want to do better. Nowadays, we're celebrating victimhood and racing to the bottom. What happened? I argue that we've largely lost our self-respect and our respect for one another.

Respect. If you have kids or grandkids these days, I cannot stress enough the importance of having them show respect. Our current culture wants them not to. Our current culture, it seems, does not want them to have the tools to succeed. Our current culture thinks it's okay for kids to be rude to their teachers and their elders. This is setting them up to fail right out of the gate. Think about it, my one employee continuously surprised people by showing them respect. If that was such a common practice, why would they be surprised? Are you seeing my point? We're being told one thing, yet what our eyes(and ears) experience in real life doesn't reflect what we're told. So, I say take command of the things that you can control. Being more respectful to one another is an easy place to start. Being a good example in your workplace is another. Teaching kids to be respectful is a bigger challenge, but I say it is 100% worth the effort. For the first time in a long time, America seems to be going backward. It is up to us, individually, to do our part to reverse that trend. Showing and giving respect is a very simple and effective way to do that. As the saying goes, the simplest solution is often the best solution. So, let's get out there and start respecting the hell out of each other!

Honoring Vietnam War Veterans: Alva Resident Richard Erschik Invited On The Collier-Lee County Honor Flight

It's been almost 50 years since the end of the Vietnam War, but the sacrifices made by the men and women who served in that conflict will never be forgotten. Among those brave soldiers was Richard Erschik, a Chicago native who was drafted into the Army in 1965 as part of President Johnson's 230,000 man call to support the U.S. war efforts in Vietnam.

On May 20, 2023, with his son Tim as his Guardian, Richard will be joining the Lee and Collier County Honor Flight to Washington, DC, to tour the monuments dedicated to his service and the service and sacrifices of his brothers and sisters. For Richard, this will be an emotional journey, and his chance to pay tribute to the many brave soldiers who served alongside him.

Richard's military journey began on October 25, 1965, when he found himself scared and alone, joining others who were being drafted into the Army. They made the bus pilgrimage together from Chicago to Ft. Knox, KY, and then on to Ft. Hood, TX, where they underwent Basic and Advanced Individual Training.

The rest, as they say, is history, chronicled in the book Richard wrote titled, "My Time Served In The United States Army," which is available on Amazon.com and Apple Books. In his book, Richard shares his experiences as a soldier, the struggles he faced, and the lasting impact the war had on his life.

Richard's participation in the Honor Flight is a reminder that we should never forget the sacrifices

made by those who served in Vietnam and other Wars. The trip to Washington, DC, will provide an opportunity for Richard and his fellow veterans to reflect on their service and to pay tribute to those who didn't make it home.

As we approach the 50th anniversary of the end of the Vietnam War, it is essential that we continue to honor those who served in that conflict. Richard Erschik's participation in the Honor Flight is a reminder that the sacrifices made by our soldiers will never be forgotten, and their service to our country will always be appreciated.

The Honor Flight returns to Ft. Myers RSW airport at 8:30pm on May 20, 2023. Visitors are invited to welcome them home.

U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary Offers One Day Boating Safety Class: The One-Day Class Is Provided By Coast Guard Auxiliary On Saturday, May 20 Submitted By Daniel Eaton

Boating enthusiasts seeking to obtain the state boating safety certificate are encouraged to enroll in a one-day responsible boating class on Saturday, May 20, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. The course will be held at the Pine Ridge Community Center, located at 15699 Pine Ridge Rd. in Fort Myers, next to the fire station and across from the tax collector's office. Completion of the course will make participants eligible for the state boating certificate.

The United States Coast Guard Auxiliary offers the one-day program every third Saturday of the month. Greg Masonic, the Flotilla Commander of Fort Myers Beach Flotilla 91, stresses the importance of education and awareness of boating hazards. Masonick says, "Attending an in-person class is an excellent opportunity for students to interact, share perspectives, and gain local knowledge. Participants learn about the importance of life jackets, risk reduction, preparedness, and exercising sound judgment."

According to Florida law, anyone born on or after January 1, 1988, who plans to operate a boat in Florida waters with an engine of 10 horsepower or more must complete an approved boating safety course and obtain a Florida boating safety ID card. This card certifies that the person has completed the required boating safety course, but it is not a boating license.

The one-day class costs \$45 per person and includes study materials. Mandatory registration is required and may be completed at www.Aux-91FMB.org or by calling 239-690-6780 option 1.

Boating is a popular recreational activity in Southwest Florida, but it can also be dangerous for the unprepared or uninformed. Human error and poor decision-making can increase the risk of accidents. According to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, in 2021, there were 51 reportable boating accidents resulting in seven fatalities and 28 injuries.

Pet Allergies

WHAT IS AN ALLERGY?

An allergy occurs when the immune system overreacts and produces antibodies to substances that it would normally tolerate. This excessive response is considered and allergic or hypersensitive reaction. Allergies can develop to any substance that a pet is exposed to. Food, fleas, seasonal environmental allergens (grasses or pollens) or indoor allergens (dust mites and molds).

WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS?

The immune system's job is to keep you healthy by fighting harmful pathogens. It does this by attacking anything it thinks could put your body in danger. Depending on the allergy, this response may involve inflammation, or a host of other symptoms.

The most common symptom associated with allergies is localized (in one area) or generalized (all over the body) itching of the skin and ears. In some pets, licking or chewing the feet, limbs or belly may lead to skin infections or recurrent ear infections. In some cases, the symp-

toms involve the respiratory system, with coughing, sneezing, and/ or wheezing. Sometimes, there may be runny discharge from the eyes or nose. In the case of food allergies, the digestive system may be affected, resulting in vomiting, diarrhea, or chronic anal gland issues.

HOW COMMON ARE ALLERGIES?

Allergies are very common and often occur after the age of 6 months. They are more commonly seen around the age of 1-2 years old. This is because it takes time for the body to become sensitized to the substance the pet is allergic to. Common pet allergies include contact allergies, food allergies, environmental allergies (or a more severe form termed Atopic Dermatitis) and flea allergies.

DIAGNOSING ALLERGIES

Diagnosing allergies can sometimes be difficult. Especially since the signs of allergies can be confused with other disorders, or they can occur simultaneously. Be prepared for your pet to receive a full diagnostic evaluation to rule out other causes

of itching and skin problems. Your veterinarian will also discuss allergy testing either by a blood test or skin test. In some instances, biopsies of the skin may be required.

TREATMENT OF ALLERGIES

Because there is no one size fits all treatment for allergies, there are many allergy treatments available for pets. Allergy treatment and control may take several months of trial and error to find a protocol that best controls your pets' signs effectively

Common Treatments ForAllergies Include:

- Anti-itch therapy: Use of daily oral or injectable medications that block itching and inflammation.
- Medicated shampoos which help keep the skin barrier healthy and prevent secondary infections
- Antihistamines aid in reducing sneezing and watery eyes.
- Special Diets which help pets avoid food allergens and help strengthen the skins barrier.
- Hyposensitization: Allergy shots which contain very small

doses of allergens, given daily to desensitize the immune system

 Antibiotics and Topical ear medications: Sometimes used to treat secondary infections to help control allergy symptoms.

There is no cure for allergies. The goal of allergy treatment is to control the clinical signs and keep your pet happy and healthy. It is important to maintain contact with your veterinarian to adjust treatments for your pet based on their response.

If you suspect that your pet may have allergies, make an appointment to have them evaluated by your veterinarian today.




